North Florida will have access to superior specialty care at PanCare's Regional Healthcare Center. With expedient funding approval, our goal is to complete this campus in 4 years with an anticipated budget of 30 million dollars. 



1943-2023

PanCare of Florida's beloved Founder, President and Chief Executive Officer, Mike Hill passed on Monday, January 16, 2023 after withstanding prolonged health issues. PanCare has lost a true visionary, and the world has lost an amazing human being. Those of us who have been

fortunate enough to know and work with Mike have lost a dear friend and an inspiring mentor. Mike leaves behind a company that only he could have built, and his spirit will forever be the foundation of PanCare.

How lucky we are to have someone that makes saying good bye so difficult.



Mike's legacy is rooted in the love he had for Northwest Florida. Early in his career, Mike served on the School Board for Bay District Schools. He was also the CEO over the Big Bend and Northwest Florida Heath Councils. Throughout Mike's career he noticed the gap in affordable healthcare and in 2003, he opened the first PanCare clinic bringing quality healthcare on a sliding fee scale; affordability to everyone. As his vision for a better community grew, so did the reach of PanCare; now with 14 clinics and 126 access sites across Northwest Florida, and operating Florida's largest mobile clinic fleet, PanCare is able to provide no-cost medical, dental, behavioral health and vision care through our School Health, TeleHealth, and Mobile programs. Mike devoted himself to our community bringing affordable healthcare to all in need. We will always remember his efforts to make this organization successful. We will honor his memory by dedicating ourselves to the work he loved so much.
